#### Discussion – Recommendations from participants of focus group

- Equip participants from field services with the knowledge of how to respond to domestic violence and with the knowledge of their legal obligations
- o The role of burnout prevention and supervision support for employees
- Provide knowledge of the methods of early recognition of risky patterns of behaviour of job applicants
- Positive role which is played in the prevention of violent conflicts by preparation for meeting the client, choice of correct timing and other situational aspects
